Theory Programs

Theory course topics: Safety fundamentals for crane operators; introduction to crane certification process; rigging knowledge; crane operation knowledge; load chart knowledge; crane rigging charts; crane maintenance and service and crane set-up and pre-trip inspections.

Practical Programs

The crane training school comprises practical training including hands-on learning. This component teaches trainees how to identify crane components and terminology. Trainees would have the opportunity to perform skills required for crane signaling, rigging and operating.

Practical course topics: Identify crane components and functions; Learn crane terminology; identify rigging and wire ropes; use remote control; pre-use inspection on crane; identify documents and regulations for rigging and wire rope; perform rigging techniques; utilize hand signals and radio; and perform proper lifting and lowering of loads.
